Quest for Fire Challenge

Using only the natural surroundings and materials of Marydale Park, your team must create and start a fire. Your team will be given three ways to start a fire, magnifying glass, steel wool and a battery and a flint rock. Let's hope the sun cooperates, or your task becomes even more challenging. The fire must be high enough to burn the rope strung over top. The team that burns through their rope will be the winner.



River Relay Challenge

Marydale Park's pools are perfect for this challenge. Your team will need to transport a basket of items from one end of the pool and back five times without losing the basket's contents. All ten team members will take part as you race against other teams and the clock.



David & Goliath Challenge

Your team must form a human catapult with the goal of hurling water filled balloons high in the sky so your team members can catch as many as possible in a large blanket. Your team will also be wearing blinders just to make it a little bit more challenging. The team that can catch the most unbroken balloon in the time provided wins.

The Archery Challenge

Teams will shoot arrows at targets or even pumpkins. After each teammate completes their shot, points will be given for each completed hit. Teams will continue to shoot until all members have completed the task.



The Puzzle Challenge

Teams will compete in a head to head race to complete the construction of a puzzle. As each piece of the puzzle is completed, the next person on your team is given the challenge of finding the next piece until you complete the task.



River of Jordan Challenge

Your team will need to create a river using mini trenches to transport your bucket of water to three designated areas. The team that get the most amount of water to each area will win. To make this more challenging, we are going to have you wear blind folds.
