Rules & Regulations

(Faith Day Challenges Games Friday, September 22, 2017)

Welcome to the Faith Day Challenge games. This day-long event will feature 10 to 15 exciting recreational activities. No matter your athletic ability, everyone will be able to participate in the C.Y.O. Faith Day Challenge Games.

(Final team registration for the event will be June 30, 2017)

TEAMS & PARTICIPANTS – Regulations / Timing / Scheduling

All events will take place as scheduled – **RAIN OR SHINE** at the C.Y.O.'s Marydale Park Outdoor Recreational Facility. In the event that safety is an issue due to severe weather (high winds, lightening), the Faith Day Challenge management will have the final decision as to event delays and/or cancellations.

NO School ID – NO PLAY – NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

- Participants must make a charitable registration donation of \$20.00 per student (\$200 per team) to participate.
- All participating students must be full-time students at the time of the event. Those who graduated in June of 2017 will not be permitted to participate.
- Your team registration form must be completed, signed and returned to the C.Y.O. prior to June 30, 2017.
- Teams are made up of 10 individuals (any combination of boys and girls).
- There are no restrictions on the number of teams per school, but students can only register and participate on one team during the day – no substitutions.
- Each team should select a Captain who will be the primary contact for event updates and registration information & collection of donations.
- All teams are encouraged to participate in all activities to receive the maximum number of points available.
- Only those students who are officially registered on a Team, or those who are volunteering, will be given the opportunity to be out of school on the day of the event.



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TEAMS & PARTICIPANTS – Regulation / Timing / Schedule

Upon arrival on the day of the event, students must go to the registration stations to confirm participation and to receive their Event Schedule with information pertaining to your Team's start times, locations, schedule of activities, site maps, etc.

- School buses and school teams are to arrive at Marydale Park starting at 8:00 a.m. on Friday, September 22, 2017. Please proceed to registration stations will be set up to confirm teams and their participants.
- Each student must show their student ID card upon registering on the day of the event to receive a registration wrist band - no wrist band, no participation.
- Teams will be given 10 to 15 minutes to rotate from challenge to challenge.
- All games must start at the designated time. If a team is late, the Game Official has the option of penalizing the late team. The official may allow for a grace period if deemed appropriate.
- Teams will receive numerous points for each Challenge based on timing, responses and activities completed.
- Teams with the most amount of points at the end of the day will be recognized for their efforts (e.g. 1st Place, 2nd Place 3rd Place).
- Teams / students must adhere to the rules of the Marydale Park facility - smoking and alcohol are not permitted. Any team member caught with alcohol, tobacco or drugs will have their team immediately disqualified from the event.

EVENT DAY TIMING – Subject to Change

- **8:00 a.m.** – Schools & buses to begin arriving at Marydale Park.
- **8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.** – Students to sign-in and receive their information packages, plus a light snack
- **9:00 a.m.** – Welcome and opening Mass, Diocese of Hamilton
- **10:00 a.m.** – Teams to make their way to the start of their first event/challenge
- **12:30 p.m.** – Lunch
- **4:30 p.m.** – Closing Ceremonies and light snacks
- **5:00 p.m.** – Bus Departures
